

Shiraz 2019

Grape Variety: Shiraz

Region: Coonawarra

Vintage: Coonawarra received good winter rains, which set up the vines well for the growing season. Temperatures during the growing season were warm with minimal heat spikes, the steady temperature continued through vintage. There were minimal vintage rains, which reduced any pressure of disease.

Oak Maturation: Selected parcels were maturated for an average of 19 months with 40% in Hogs Heads and remainder in older barriques.

Cellaring Potential: Will age gracefully for up to 10 years.

Colour: Deep red with magenta hues.

Nose: The Shiraz opens with plums, violets and spice. There are sweet notes of mocha and coffee, a very inviting Shiraz.

Palate: The palate is rich yet restrained, supple yet driven, round and friendly but still showing characteristics of elegant cool climate Shiraz. This is a bright, crunchy and pleasing wine.

Food Matching: Aged cheddar or a vegan chocolate tart.
